



POLICY STATEMENT

At Jarrahdale Primary School, our uniform is an important part of creating a safe, inclusive, and respectful learning environment. Wearing the school uniform promotes a sense of belonging, equality, and pride in our school community. The School Board and Parents and Citizens Association strongly support the Uniform Policy, and all students are expected to wear the uniform as part of their commitment to being active and respectful members of our school.

GUIDELINES

Students are expected to wear the designated school uniform during school hours and on all school excursions. Parents are encouraged to support this expectation by ensuring their child wears the uniform each day. Uniforms should be clean, neat, and well maintained at all times. All items of clothing should be clearly labelled with the student's name; however, names should not be visible while the uniform is being worn.

EXEMPTIONS

The Principal has the authority to grant exemptions based on the following grounds:

1. Unavailability of a required uniform item at the time of need.
2. Matters concerning student health.
3. Matters related to the student's religious beliefs and/or cultural background or that of their family.
4. Individual family situations, which will be considered on a case-by-case basis, if necessary.
5. The Principal will communicate to the staff whenever a student has been granted a temporary or permanent exemption from the dress code.

NON-COMPLIANCE

When a student is out of uniform, the following action will be taken:

- The student will be asked to report to the Administration Office to change into an appropriate uniform item and/or remove the non-uniform item.
- Parents will be contacted to deliver the appropriate uniform item.
- The non-uniform item will be returned to the student at the end of the day.
- Students will be asked to removed jewellery, make up, nail polish and fashion accessories if they arrive at school wearing these items.

EXCURSIONS

For safety and organisational reasons, students are required to wear the official school uniform during excursions and interschool events, unless alternative arrangements have been communicated. The school's "no uniform, no participation" approach ensures consistency and fairness in adhering to the uniform policy.

PURCHASING UNIFORMS

The P&C Uniform Coordinator processes multiple orders throughout the year, and we ask parents to use this service to ensure consistency in colours and styles.
